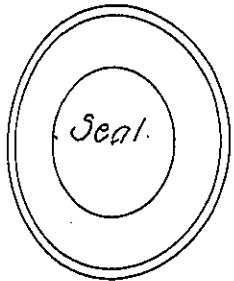

These are to require thee to Resurvey to the sd Griffith Owen the sd two parcels of Land containing in the whole four hundred and one Acres and a half and make Returns thereof in one Tract into the Surveyors Office at Philad<sup>a</sup> where this Warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee Attested by the Secretary who is also to take a Duplicate of thy Return into his office Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philad<sup>a</sup> the 11<sup>th</sup> of the 12<sup>th</sup> Moth 1701.
