

Pursuant to a Warrant under the hand and seal of the Proprietary and Governour to me directed bearing date the 14<sup>th</sup> day of the 10<sup>th</sup> month 1700.

I do hereby certify that I have caused to be surveyed and laid out unto George Pierce (upon Rent or Purchase as hereafter shall be agreed upon between the Proprietary & Governour and him) a certain Tract of Land situate on the South side of Brandywine Creek in the County of Chester, beginning at a post standing in the Line of a Tract of Land Seated by George and Michael Harland, from thence by the said Line of marked trees North North West one hundred sixty and one perches to another post being a Corner of their said Tract from thence North two hundred forty and six perches to a marked white oak, from thence West by a Line of marked trees one hundred forty and nine perches to a marked black oak, from thence South four hundred perches to a post standing in the Line of a Tract of Land laid out to Joseph Pennock, from thence by the said Line of marked trees East two hundred and eleven perches to the first mentioned post, containing four hundred and two acres and fifty four perches. Surveyed the 25<sup>th</sup> day of the 10<sup>th</sup> month 1700, and Returned according to y<sup>e</sup> above said survey and bounds into the Proprietary and Governour's Secretary's Office the 16<sup>th</sup> day of the 2<sup>d</sup> month 1701.
