dated the 27th of September Anno 1717.

Surveyd and Laid out the 14th day of October 1717 unto Hance Pupather
 a certain Tract of Land on Little Conestogo Creek in the County of Chester Be-
 ginning at a marked White Oak at a Corner of a Tract Laid out to Hance
 Pupather and Christian Hersey Then west north west by the same
 four hundred and Eighty Acres to a Hickery tree Then North North East
 two hundred forty eight Acres to a Small White Oak Then east south
 east four hundred and Eighty Acres to a Small Black oak and ^{then} South
 South West two hundred forty Eight Acres to the place of Beginning Con-
 taining Seven hundred acres with an addition or allowance of Six & Cent.
