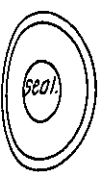


Pennsylvania.

In pursuance of a Grant made thee by the Proprietary These are to Authorize thee to survey and lay out to thy self within the Welch Tract a certain parcel of Land formerly laid out for three hundred acres to Daniel Harry Renter but by him quit-ted & thereupon become vacant, also one hundred Acres of Vacant Land Situate between two Tracts belonging to thy self in Radnor Associating to thy self two substantial honest freeholders within the said Tract not unskilful in Surveys and make Returns thereof into the General Surveyor's Office at Philadelphia where this warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delivered to thee certified by the Secretary who is also to take a duplicate of thy Return into his Office. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 25th of the 12th mo. 1701.
