Upon an agreement this day made with Daniel Macffarsen of the Township of Kennet in Chester County for one hundred Twenty five acres of Land Joining on the Tract where he now dwells for which He agrees to pay to the use of the Trustees of the Province Twenty Pounds mory of Pensilv^a for the whole and y^e yearly quitrent of one shilling Sterling for the hundred acres and in like proportion thereunto for the five & Twenty acres These are to Authorize and require thee to Survey & lay out or cause to be Survey'd and laid out unto the said Daniel Macffarsen contiguous with the adjoining Lands the said one hundred twenty five Acres provided the same be clear of all other Surveys and Lawfull claims, and make returns thereof into the Secretarys which Survey in case the said Daniel fulfill the above agreement within one month after the date hereof shall be Valid otherwise the same is to be void as if it had never been made nor this warrant ever granted Given under our hands & the Seal of the Province at Philad^a y^e 10th. day of Decemb^r A.D. 1718.
