or cause to be surveyed
sd Number of Acres in ye County of Chester next to ye Township already layd out for
ye Friends of Wales joyning to ye County of Philadelphia, or if fill'd also, & not
so many Lotts, w^{ch} may containe Eleven hundred Acres, in ye same Township
vacant, yⁿ in ye next Township to y^t laying y^m all next to ye Friends of Wales
on another side, & make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office. Given at
Philadelphia ye 18th ^{mo} 11th, 1683.
