



A Draught of a tract of Land situate on the South side of Brandywine Creek in the County of Chester surveyed the 11th day of the 2^d month 1701 unto Christopher Pennock in right of Francis and George Rogers purchasers of five thousand acres by them sold to George Collett, containing three hundred acres, pursuant to a warrant under the hand and seal of the Proprietary and Governour to me directed bearing date the 7th day of the 1st month 170^o, and is accordingly Returned into the Secretary's Office the 25th day of the 4th month 1701.
