

Pursuant to a Warrant under the hand and Seal of the Proprietary and Govern-
our to me directed bearing date the 7th day of the 1st month 170⁹.

I do hereby certify that I have caused to be surveyed unto Christopher Pennock a
certain Tract of Land situate on the South side of Brandywine Creek in the
County of Chester in right of Francis and George Rogers purchasers of five thou-
sand acres by them sold to George Collett, beginning at a corner marked black oak
being a Corner of Richard Crosby's Land, from thence by his Line North four hundred
perches to a Corner post, from thence West one hundred and twenty perches to a Corner
hickery, from thence South four hundred perches to a Corner post standing by a Street
or Road, from thence East by the same one hundred and twenty perches to the first
mentioned Corner black oak, Containing three hundred acres, Laid out the 11th day of
the 2^d month 1701, and Returned according to the above said survey and bounds
into the Proprietary and Governour's Secretary's Office the 25th day of the 4th
month 1701.
