



Pursuant to a warrant from ye Comiss<sup>rs</sup> of Prop<sup>ty</sup> beareing date ye 8<sup>th</sup> of ye 4<sup>th</sup> mo 1703 directed and ordered for the Regulating of a certaine tract of Land Laid out to Richard Ingels in Chester County Contrary to order and Method, I do Certify that I have altered the first bounds of the said tract Laying it uniforme with the adjacent Lands begining at a stake set in ye ground by a Red oak marked in ye Welsh Line and being a Corner of a certaine tract of Land of John Haignes from David Loyd & Isaac Norris from thenc by a Line of Marked trees North North West 504 perches to a stake set in ye ground by vaccant Land thenc by ye same East North East by a Line of Marked trees 200 perches to another stake set in ye ground from thenc by a Line of marked trees deviding it from Richard Thomas Land South South East 504 perches to a stake set in the ground by a Hickry Sapline marked being a Corner of ye said Richard Thomas Land in ye Line of ye said Haignes Land from thenc by a Line of marked trees and ye same Land West South West 200 perches to ye place of begining Containeing 630 acrs of Land and is according to ye bounds above described Return'd into ye General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia ye 26<sup>th</sup> day of ye 4<sup>th</sup> mo 1703. pr David Powell.
