

This may certify that pursuant to a Warrant under the hands of the Commissioners of Province, bearing date the Two and Twentieth 11th mo 1711. There was Surveyed and Laid out on the 20th day of the 12-Month A.D. 1711/2 unto Israel Pemberton - a tract of Land near Pecquea Creek in the county of Chester. Beginning at a black oak at a corner of a Tract lately laid out to Richard Smead and extending thence East three hundred and ninety perches to a corner tree Thence North west by west Four hundred and twenty perches to a Post Thence, three hundred and ninety perches to a post at another corner of the said R^d Smeads land Then by the same land south by East four hundred and twenty perches to the place of the Beginning Containing one Thousand acres

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this second day of October, 1909.
