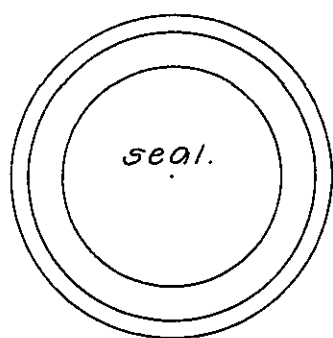

At the Request of Richard Miles of the Township of Radnor that we would Grant him a Resurvey on One hundred and Seventy Acres and a half of Land laid out in the said Township, Part thereof by virtue of a General Warrant from the Prop^{rs} for laying out the Welch Tract, bearing date the 13th of the first Month 1684 in right of the s^d Rich^d, Purchase of one hundred Acres of Rich^d Davies first purchaser of 5000 Acres and fifty thereof part of one hundred Acres purchased for this Province, the remainder being on rent is now to be cleared to the s^d Rich^d: These are to require thee forthwith to Resurvey to the said Richard Miles the said One hundred and seventy Acres & a half of Land as now located and seated in the place aforesaid, and make Returns thereof into the General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delv^d to thee certified by the Secretary who is also to take a Duplicate of thy Return into his office. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 18th of the 12th Month 1701.
