These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey to the said Samuel Miles the said number of two hundred and seventy Acres located and Seated as aforesaid and make Returns into the General Surveyors office at Philadelphia where this Warrant is to remain and a copy thereof to be deliv^d to thee certified by the Secretary who is also to take a Duplicote of thy Return into his Office, Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 18th of the 12th Month 1701.
