



By Vertue of a warrant from Edward Pennington Surveyr Generall bearing date the 19th day of ye 1st month 1701 directed unto me I hereby Certify into his Office that I have Reasurveyed the 29 day of the 6th mo^o Ensueing unto Katharine Morgan a certain tract of Land being within the bounds of the Welsh tract begining at a post sett in the ground Near a Small branch from whence by a Line of marked trees, East North East 320 perches to a stake sett in the ground from thence South South East 106 perches to another Stake Sett in the ground from thence west South West 320 by a Line of marked trees to a post sett in the ground in a Line that comes from Radnor Township from thence by the same Line of marked trees North North west 106 perches to the place of begining Containing two hundred and 12 Acres of Land
