At ye request of Robert Turner, yt I would grant him to take (obl.) his Lot in high street answerable to his Purchase of five thousand acres (-o b l -) are to will & require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him in ye sd street on Delaware side a lott proportionable to his Purchase, and make returns thereof into my Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia ye 14th of ye ¹⁷⁷⁹ 4th 1683.
