At ye request of Robert Vernon, Purchaser of six hundred & Twenty five acres of land, yt I would grant him to take up his proportion, wthin ye Liberties of ye City. These are to will & require thee forthwth to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him his proportion answerable to his Purchase wthin ye bounds thereof, he seating & improving ye same according to Regulation, & make returns thereof into my Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia, ye 19th of ye 4th mo. 1684.
