



By virtue of a warrant from Edward Perinington Surveyor General bearing date the 10th of this instant directed unto me I hereby certify into his office that I have surveyed and laid out unto Richard Vickris a certain piece of land in the city Liberty beginning at a marked maple in a small branch neere Germantowne line from there west south west one hundred and fifty ^{four} perches to a stake sett in ye ground from there north north west thirty one perch to another stake in the line of Benjamin Morgans land from there east north east by a line of marked trees one hundred and seventy six perches to post in the Germantowne line from (bl) there south 10 degrees west by a the said branch thirty ^{eight} (obl) + perches to the place of beginning. Containing and laid out for thirty and two acres of land the 14th 6 mo. 1700.
