in ye County of Philadelphia. These are to will & require three forthwth to
survey or cause to be survey'd unto y^{rs} five thousand six hundred acres
joyning together in ye aforementioned County, where not already taken up
according to ye method of townships appointed by me, and make returns
thereof into my Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia ye 14th of ye 12th
mo. 1683.
