E by E. halfe a point eastaly 194 perches to the place of beginning. 80<sup>ac<sup>rs</sup></sup> beginning at a small Saplin markt being a corner Tree of W<sup>m</sup> Palmers land thence N. W 90 perches by Vacant land to a stake in the line of Richard Vickeris's land. thence by the same W. S. W 96 perches, thence N. N. W 39 perches ~~by vacant land~~ to a stake in Berj<sup>a</sup> Morgans line, thence by the said line W. S. W 70 perches & 1/2 thence by Vacant land & a line of markt trees S. S. E 123 perches to a post in the said Palmers line thence by the same E. N. E 116 1/2 perches to the place of beginning.
