These are therefore in ye Proprietarys name to will and require thee to resur-
vey or cause to be resurveyed both their tracts of land in such manner as
wee may judg where most convenient to divide the same equally so as
to leave Otto his proportion and the remainder thereof to be parted
to ye said Tucker and make returne thereof to ye Secretarys office dated
at Philad ye 16th 6 mo. 1690.
