



By virtue of a warrant from Edward Pennington Surveyr. Generall bearing date 5th of 2^d month 1701 directed unto me I do hereby certify into his office that I have surveyd and laid out unto Joseph Tanner a certaine tract of land in the County of Philadelphia begining at a corner stake deviding it from Nathaniell Pyles land from thence north east by a line of marked trees 500 perches to a stake sett in the ground hard by a w^oke marked from thence by a line of marked trees north west 96 perches to a post sett in the ground deviding it from Joseph Pikes land from thence by a line of marked trees south west 500 perches to another stake deviding it from the said Pikes land from thence south east 196 perches to a line of marked trees to ye plac^e of begining. Containeing and laid out for Three hundred acres of land ye 21st of ye 4th mo 1701.
