 owne Lott there on delaw.^s side ffor ye which ye said Turner have
 given up ^{unto ye propriet^r use forever} 132 foot ffrant^r in ye High street on Schuylkill proportion-
 able to John Gee and Comp^{rs}. Purchase of 5000 acres whose purchase
 ye said Turner have bought.

These are therefore in ye Proprietaries name to will & require thee forthwith
 to survey or cause to be surveyed unto him ye lott aforesaid and make
 returns thereof into ye Secretaries, dated at Philadelphia ye 30th of ye 5th
 mo. 1692.
