grant him to take up ^{two} thirty acres of Liberty land in right of an old Purchase of
two thousand acres by him made in England, These are to require thee forthwith
to survey or cause to be surveyed unto him the said number of acres within ye
Liberty land of ye city Philadelphia where not already taken up And make
returns thereof into my Secretaries office Given under my hand and seal at
Philadelphia the 13th day of the fifth month 1700.
