By the Commissioners of Property

Upon an agreement this day made with Jonas Yocum of the County of Philadelphia for three hundred acres of land on the River Schoolkill joining to a tract of land laid out to Andreas Rudman near Mariatanny Creek for which he agrees to pay to the Proprietors use sixty Pounds for the whole and the usual yearly quitrent of one shilling Sterling for every hundred acres. These are to authorize and require thee to survey or cause to be surveyed unto the said Jonas Yocum in the place aforesaid the said quantity of three hundred acres of land that has not been already surveyed nor appropriated and make a return thereof into the Secretarys office which survey in case the said Jonas fulfill the above agreement within one year after the date hereof shall be valid otherwise the same is to be void as if it had never been made nor this warrant ever granted. Given under our hands and seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 22<sup>d</sup> day of the 12<sup>th</sup> 1714/5.
