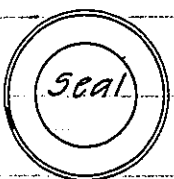

At ye request of Samuel Allen yt I would grant him to take up one hundred acres of land in part of his Purchase, to be layd out to ye hundred acres he now seats upon. These are to will & require three fourths to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye said number of acres in ye aforemention'd place, provided it be not already taken up according to ye method of Townships appointed by me, and make returns thereof into my Secretarys office Given at Philadelphia ye 20th of ye 1st mo. 1683.
