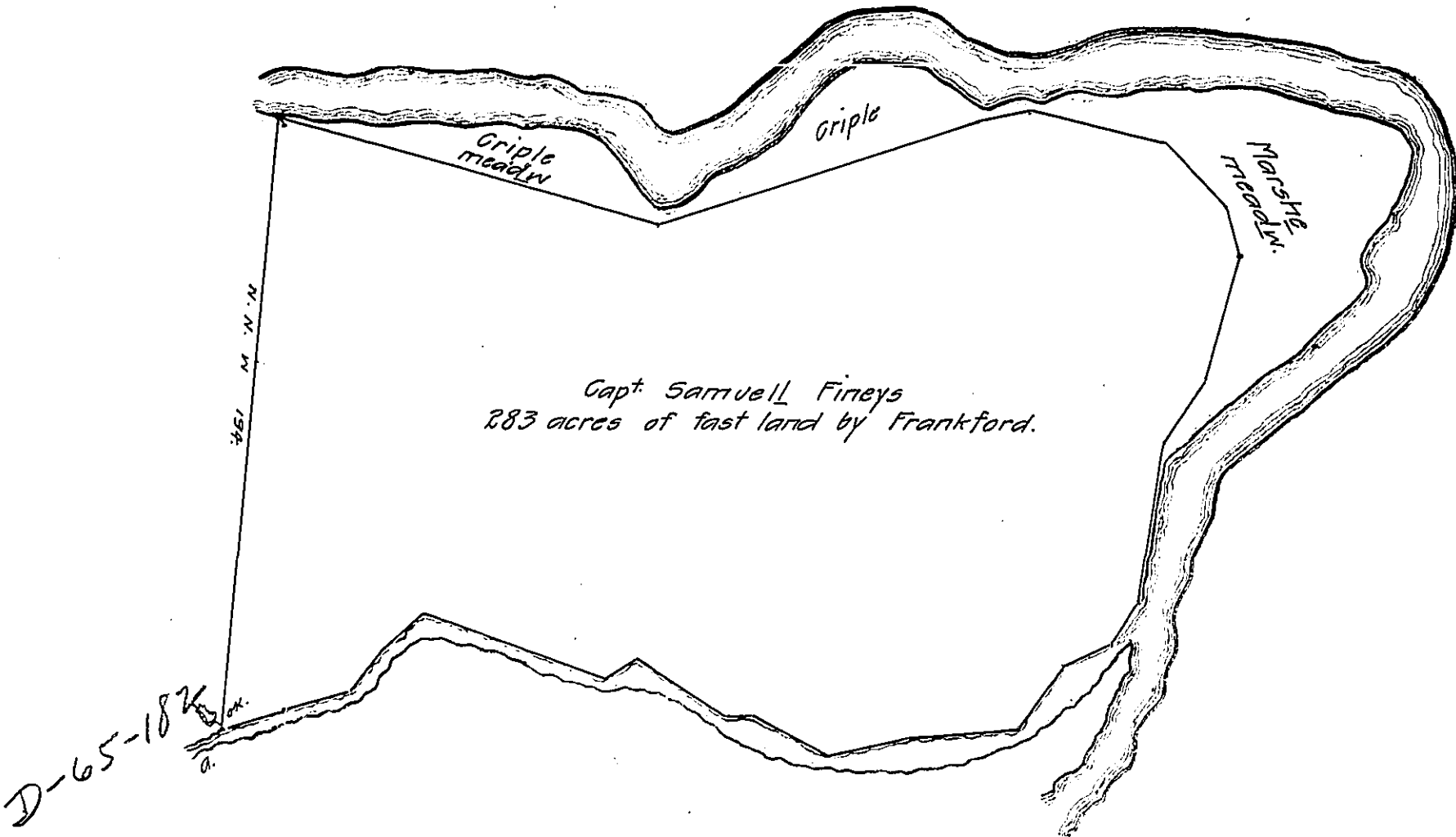

Pursuant to a warrant from the Prop^r Commiss^{rs} of Prop^rty directed unto me bearing date ye 16th day of 9th 1702. I do certify that I have resurveyed unto Capt Samuel Finney a certaine tract of land in the county of Philadelphia beginning at a black oak sapling standing by a small branch of Tacony Creek being a corner deviding it from other land of ye Capt. Finney from thence by the severall courses of ye said branch 268 perches to ye maine creek thence by the severall courses of ye same 78 perches to the Marsh belonging to ye said land thence by ye course deviding the Fast land and Marsh 169 perches Ditto 112, thence by the said creek 130 perches w^o stake deviding it from the aforesaid land thence by a line of marked trees northnorthwest 194 perches to ye plac^e of Beginning containeing 283 acres of land & is according to ye bounds above described Returnid into ye Generall survey^rs office at Philadelphia.
