At ye request of John Vattman, yt I would grant him to take up a piece of Ground on ye River Delaware fitt to build boats & Sloops in. These are to will & require thee forthwth to survey or cause to be surveyd unto him a Lott 49 foot front & in length 100 foot downwards in Vine street upon my Lott next to Robert Gay, where I shall direct, & make returns thereof into my Secretarys office. Given at Philadelphia ye 31st of ye 5th mo. 1684.
