The above described tract of land was surveyed unto Isaac Richardson situate in the township of Salisbury in Lancaster County containing 332^{as} 26^{ps} beside the allowance of six P Cent. Being part of a Tract of 500^{as} of land Originally surveyed for the use of the Proprietaries then in the County of Chester.
