

By virtue of a warrant under the hands of the Commiss<sup>rs</sup> of Property and the seal of the Province dated the 26<sup>th</sup> day of ye 11<sup>th</sup> month 1702 for laying out unto Benj<sup>n</sup> Furlow 50 acres of land on the west side of Schuylkill —

Surveyd and laid out unto Benjamin Furlow the 22<sup>d</sup> of ye first month 170<sup>3</sup> a tract of land on the west side of ~~Schuyl~~ Schuylkil in the Liberties of the City Philadelphia beginning at a stake in the line of Haverford township from thence west south west ninety perches to a second stake near the mill Creek Then by the several Courses <sup>thereof</sup> South 39 deg east forty per. south 12 deg east fifty two perches to a white oak sapling marked by the said Creek Then east north east ninety four per to a stake in the line of Will Robert's land then by the said land north north west ninety per. to the beginning containing fifty acres surveyd by David Powel & returned into ye Gen<sup>l</sup> Surveyor's office ye 5<sup>th</sup> <sup>2 mo. 1703.</sup> Revised in the said office
