



By ye Commission^{rs} impower'd to grant lotts & land in ye Province of Pennsylvania & ye territories thereunto belonging.

At ye request of William Yardley Purchaser of five hundred acres of land yt we would grant him to take up his proportion of land w^{thin} ye Liberties: These are to will & require thee in ye Proprietary's name forthwth to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye same w^{thin} ye bounds thereof, he seating & improving ye same w^{thin} six months from ye date of the survey, & make returns thereof into ye Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia, ye 24th 7th 1684.
