

Penn-sylvania

Whereas I have occasion to prepare the draughts and Mapps of the respective Counties of this Province that the Govern<sup>r</sup> may seeg know their right situations; and where as by all the Surveys and draughts formerly taken & made, the dry Lands generally were survey'd & not the marshes and swamps. To the end therefore that I may be enabled to make true Mapps of the Counties, and how they ly and beare along the river Delaware, & to finde the right distances from the dry Lands. That so both the dry Lands, swamps & marshes may be truly posited and aptly laid down in y<sup>e</sup> draughts.

I hereby authorize theeby vertue of the power given me by patent from the proprietary Govern<sup>r</sup> to Survey and measure ~~the~~ exactly all marshes & swamps along the Skoolhill down from Peter Yokams, to the river Delaware, & so down the river, to Tinecom Island, & thence up to the dry Land, and thence along between the sd marshes & swamps & dry Lands untill it come to the said Peter Yokamis again, & to take notice of the respective Creeks, great & small, & divisions of all separations of Lands & marshes & swamps that they may be distinguished, & exactly put down in the Mapp. And to make me a returne of the said work for which this shall by thy autherity.
