Survey'd and laid out unto John Henry Sproagel one hundred acres of land in the Mannor of Springfield in the County of Philadelphia. beginning at Corner post of Jonas Smith's land, from thence Extending south west by west by the said Smith's land one hundred and sixty perches to a post for another Corner, then by the said Mannor land North west by North one hundred perches to a post for another Corner, thence again by the said Mannor land North east by east one hundred and sixty perches to a large white oak Marked. thence south east by south by the line of ~~General~~ Germantown land one hundred perches to the place of beginning. Containing one hundred acres as aforesaid.
