At ye Request of John Burge, Purchaser, y^t I would grant him to take up Three hundred Acres of Land in ye County of Philadelphia. These are to will and require thee forth wth to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him beyond Skulkill on ye North side of Darbey Creek the said Number of Acres in a place not already taken up according to ye method of Townships appointed by me, and make returns there of into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 24th of ye 1st Mo^o 1683.
