

By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietary and Governour dated the  
 21<sup>st</sup> day of 8<sup>th</sup> <sup>Anno 1701</sup> <sub>A</sub> for laying unto Andreas Rudman for the use of himself  
 and several of the Swedes Ten thousand acres of land. There is  
 survey'd and laid out unto Peter Boon. One Thousand acres of land part  
 of ~~the~~ the Said Ten thousand acres. Scituate near Manatawny of the East  
 Side of Schuylkil in the County of Philadelphia. Beginning at a post by  
 the River Schuylkil at the Corner of Andrew Rudmans Land. Then  
 by the same North twenty degrees east one thousand two hundred and  
 fifteen perches to a post. Then by vacant land East South east one hun-  
 dred and thirty two perches to a post. then by the line of Matthias Hol-  
 ston's land south twenty degrees west one thousand ~~and~~ two hun-  
 dred and ten perches to Schuylkil river. Then by the same bounding  
 there with to the place of the beginning. Survey'd by David Powel  
 the 28. 5<sup>th</sup> 1704.
