At the Request of Joseph Jarvis. That we would Grant him to
 Seal. Take up Six Hundred and fifty Acres of Land in this Province
 the Remaining part of one thousand Acres purchased by John
 March of Nether Hayford in the County of Oxford in Great Britain Carpenter,
 of the Propriet^r. by Indentures of Lease and Release bearing Date the El-
 eventh and Twelfth days of the Eighth Month 1681 which said Six Hundred
 and fifty Acres of Land. The said John March by his Attorney Joseph Kir-
 kbride Sold unto The said Joseph Jarvis as by their Deed bearing Date
 the third Day of the first month 1711 $\frac{1}{2}$ appears.

These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd
 unto the said Joseph Jarvis According to the Method of Townships Appo-
 inted the said Quantity of Six hundred and fifty Acres of Land in the sd
 Province that has not been already Survey'd nor Appropriated nor is
 Seated by the Indians and make a Returne there of into the Secretarys
 Office which Survey in Case the said Joseph Jarvis shall at all times he-
 re after Disclaime and resigne all pretences whatsoever to any Lands laid
 out or pretended to be Laid out to ye said Joseph in the aforesaid Right
 shall be Valid otherwise the same is to be Void as if it had never been
 made nor this Warrant Ever Granted Given under our hands and Seale
 of the Province at Philadelphia ye 30th day of the fourth Month Anno
 Din 1714.
