



By Virtue of A Warrant from the Commissioners of Property bearing Date the 5th Day of the 3^d Mo^r 1719. Surveyed and laid out for Derrick Janson A Certain Tract of Land Scituate Near a branch of Perkeomie In the County of Philadelphia begining at a Corner Post of a Peice of land Reputed John Humsteads. Thence by the same North East Two hundred Perches to a hickery saplin marked for a Corner. thence by Vacant Land North west Two hundred Thirty four Perches to a Post. thence by Vact Land South West Two hundred Perches to a large white oak standing in the Societys line. thence by the same South East Two hundred thirty four Perches to the place of begining. Two hundred seventy five Acres with Allowance of six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent. Surveyed August 18th 1720.
