unto David Jones late of Merionethshire in Wales two hundred and
fifty Acres of my Land on the West Side of Shuykill within the
Bounds of the Liberties of Philadelphia to be bounded to the
Eastward with the Land Seated by Hugh Roberts, to the Northward
with Will^m Edwards, to the Southw^d with a line to be runnⁿ par-
allel to the Line of William Warner at the distance of twe-
nty perches from the same and to the Westw^d with my
Vacant Land. Reserving fifty Acres on the Northeast cor-
ner adjacent to Jonathan Wynne and Hugh Roberts, and
Make Returns there of into my Secretaries Office.
