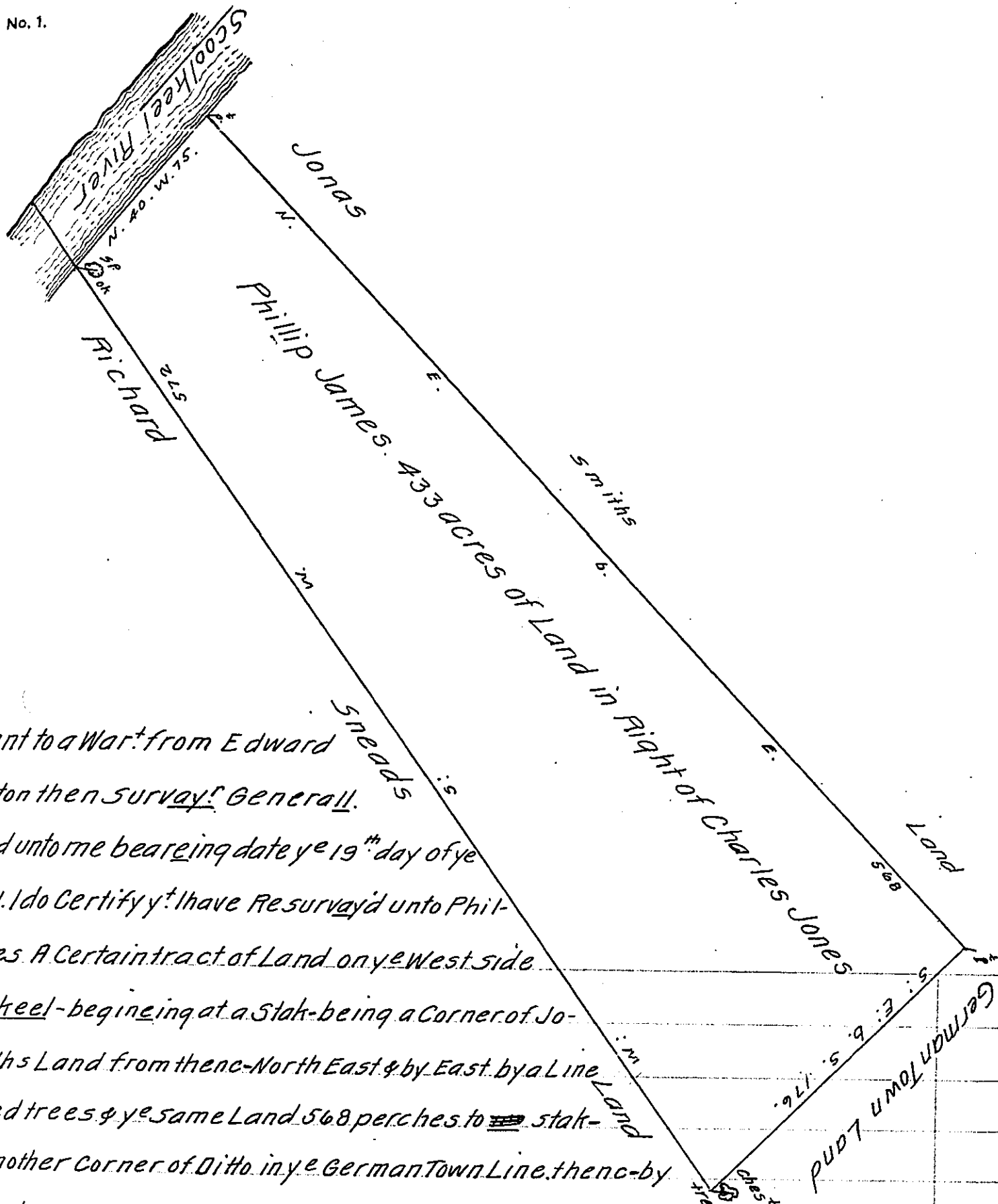

Pursuant to a War.<sup>t</sup> from Edward Penington then Survey<sup>r</sup> Generall. directed unto me beareing date ye 19<sup>th</sup> day of ye 1<sup>st</sup> mo<sup>o</sup> 1701. I do Certify<sup>t</sup> have Resurveyd unto Phillip James A Certain tract of Land on ye West side of Scolkeel - beineing at a Stak - being a Corner of Jonas Smiths Land from thenc North East & by East by a Line of Marked trees & ye same Land 568 perches to ~~the~~ stak - being another Corner of Ditto. in ye German Town Line. thenc by Ditto South East & by East: 176 perches to a Chestnut marked being a Corner of Richard Sneads Land. thenc by a Line of Marked trees & ye same Land West south West 572 perches to a Spanish ok. marked by ye River Scolkeel. thenc by ye severall Courses of ye said River North 40 degrees west 75 perches to ye place of beineing. Containeing 433 acres of Land and is according to ye bounds above described. Resurveyd ye 24<sup>th</sup> of ye 4<sup>th</sup> mo<sup>o</sup> Next Ensuieing ye date of ye sd War.<sup>t</sup> and Return'd into ye Generall Survey<sup>r</sup>s Office at Philladelphia ye 9<sup>th</sup> day of ye 9<sup>th</sup> mo<sup>o</sup> 1702.
