Humphrey Morrey & self sold to Derick Johnson five Hundred Acres of Land to be by him taken up in Pensilvania and to be surveyed to him in part of a Warr^t from the Commissioners of property as by Deeds of Lease & release at Large Appears we therefore desire that the same quantity of Land May Return to him in his owne Name and be a Disce^mpt out of one of our Warr^{ts} for Lands in Right of Mr William Bacons first purchase: Signed by my self & behalfe of sd Morrey & selfe the 1st of October 1720.
