 17th of ye 5th M^o last (directed to me) I hereby Certify into his Secretary's
 office, y^t I have caused to be Surveyed & set out unto Thomas Jones
 Purchaser, his Lott in the City of Philadelphia the 24th of ye said
 Moneth, Scituate between the seventh and Eight Streets from Skoo-
 lhill - Containing in breadth forty nine foot & a half and in length
 three hundred and six foot; bounded Northward wth the back
 of vacant Lotts, Eastward wth Thomas Millard's Lott, South-
 ward ^{wth} Mulberry Street formerly called Holme Street. West w-
 ard wth a vacant Lott. And is accordingly Entered and Recorded
 - my office Philadelphia this 5th of the 4th Moneth 1684.
