

By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietary and Governour bearing date the 21<sup>st</sup> of 8<sup>r</sup>. 1701 for laying out unto Andreas Rudman for the use of himself and several of the Swedes ten Thousand acres of Land. There is Survey'd and laid out unto Justa Justason in part of the sd ten thousand acres. One thousand acres of land Scituate on the East side of Schuylkil - in the County of Philadelphia. Beginning at a post by the River Schuylkil at the Corner of Mounse Jones's land. then running by the same North twenty degrees east Eight hundred and Seventy perches to a post. Then East South east by the said Mounse Jones's Land and the land of Andreas Rudman One hundred thirty nine perches to a post in the line of the sd Rudmans land. then ~~by the~~ North twenty degrees East four hundred sixty five perches to a post. thence West north west by Vacant Land two hundred & ten perches to a post. Then by the line of Mounse Jones land South twenty degrees west one thousand two hundred and ninty perches to the River Schuylkil. Then Down the same bounding on the same to the Beginning.
