

By virtue of A warrant Baring date the - of the - moth 1684 survey-
 ed and layed out to John Gennet two hundred Acres of Land one the
 East side of scholekill begining at A white oke on the south side of a
little runn of water and by the scholekill side, thence E.N.E. 530 perches
 to a post for a corner, thence N.W.b.N. 70 perches to another post for
 a corner, and thence W.S.W. 534 perches to a red oke standing by the
scholekill marked for another corner, and thence down by the scholekill
 to the first mentioned white oke ^{acres} q^t two hundred x of Land.
