By virtue of A warrant Bearing date the - of the - moth 1684 surveyed and layed out to John Gennet two hundred Acres of Land one the East side of Scholekill beginning at A white oke on the south side of a little runn of water and by the Scholekill side, thence E. N. E. 530 perches to A post for a corner, thence N. W. b. N. 70 perches to another post for a corner, and thence W. S. W. 534 perches to a red oke standing by the Scholekill marked for another corner, and thence down by the Scholekill to the first mentioned white oke. q^t two hundred ^{acres} of Land.
