



By Virtue of a Warrant from The Commissioners of Property dated the fifth of the 3^d month 1719. Surveyed & laid out for Derick Janson of Germantown a Certain peice of Land Situate in Oley on Menacasic Creek in the County of Philadelphia. beginning at a Marked blackoak a Corner of George Boon's land North West by Vacant Land Eighty perches to a post in the line of Samuel Shoabs land. Thence by ye same South West Sixty perches to a hicker a Corner of the said Samuel Shoabs land. Thence by the same North West One hundred thirty Two perches to a post in the said Sam^l Shoabs line, thence by Vacant Land South West fifty Eight perches to a spanish oak marked for a Corner. Thence by Vacant land South East Two hundred and Ten perches to a post in the line of the said George Boon's land. Thence by the same North East One hundred & Eighteen perches to the place of beginning. Containing One hundred Acres with Allowance of Six & Cent.
