

By Virtue of a Warrant from The Commissioners of Property dated the fifth of the 3d month 1719. Surveyed glaid out for Derick Janson. of Germantown a Certain peice of Land Situate in Oley on Menacasie Creek in the County of Philadelphia. beginning at a Marked blackoak. aCorner of George Boon's land North West by Vacant Land Eighty per ches to a post in the line of Samuel Shoabs land. Thence by ye Same South West Sixty perches to a hickera Corner of the Said Samuel Shoabs land. The nce by the Same North West One hundred thirty Two perches to a post in the Said Sam! Shoobs line, thence by Vacant Land South West fifty Eight perches to a spanish oak marked for a Corner Thence by Vacant land South East Two hundred and Ten perches to a post in the line of the Said George Boon's land. Thence by the Same North East One hundred & Eighteen perches to the place of beginning. Containing One hundred Acres with Allowance of Six & Cent. Survey-febr 220 1724/5
