By Virtue of A Warrant ^{from} the Commissioners of Property bearing Date ^{first} The ~~first~~ Day of May 1719, Surveyed and laid out a Certain Tract of land for Richard Gregory. Situate on Manahatany Creek Near Oley in the County of Philad^a. Begining at a Corner Post of Anthony Lee's land, Then N.E by the same Two hundred and forty Perches to a large White Oak Tree being also a Corner of ye ^{s^d} Lee's Land. Thence N. West by Vacant Land one hundred forty one perches And An half To a Corner Stake. Thence South West by Vacant land Two hundred & forty per^s. To A Corner Stake. Thence ^{South East} by Vacant land And land of ^{s^d} Lees one hundred forty one perches And An half To the place of begining. Contain Two hundred ^{with six & cent allowance} Acres of land. Surveyed December the 5th Day 1719 #
