 ye sd Number of Acres as convenient as may be where not already
 taken up according to ye Method of Township appointed by ye Pro-
 prietary & Govern^r; he seating & improving ye same wth in six Mo-
 nths from the Date of Survey & make returns thereof into ye
 Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 12th of ye 7th mo. 1684.
