

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietari^e & Gov^r for laying out unto Andreas Rudman ten thousand acres of land for the use of himself and several of the Swedes. bearing date the 21st day of 8^r 1701.

There was Surveyd and laid out the 28th of the fifth Month 1704 unto Mounse Jones four hundred and Ninety eight acres of land scituate on the East Side of Schulki in the County of Philadelphia. Beginning at a Corner post of John Cocks Land Thence by the same North twenty degrees East One Thousand two hundred and fifteen perches to a post. Then East South east by vacant land sixty eight perches to a post. Then South twenty Degrees West by the line of Justa Justason his land One thousand two hundred and Ninety perches to a post by Schuylkil River. Then up the same to the Beginning
