

By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietarie & Govt for laying out unto Andreas Rudman ten thousand acres of land for the use of himself and several of the swedes, bearing ^{date} the 21st day of 1701.

There was Survey'd and laid out the 28th of the fifth Month 1704 unto Mounse Jones four hundred and two acres of land, Scituate on the East side of Schuylkill-in the County of Philadelphia, beginning at a post by the River Schuylkill at the Corner of Justa Justasons ~~land~~ ^{North} land. Then by the line of the said Justa Justasons land North twenty degrees East Eight hundred and Seventy perches to a post again by the said Justa Justasons land East South East Seventy three perches to a post. Then by the line of Andreas Rudmans land South twenty degrees west Eight hundred Ninety and six perches to the Schuylkill-River. Then up the same on the Courses thereof to the Beginning.
