


Whereas by my Warr^t bearing date the 26th of the 7th mo 1701. I required
 thee to lay out for ye Company of German Purchasers 22025 Ac-
 res of Land fronting the River Skuykill the breadth of about
 600⁰ perches, and whereas the sd Germans have requested that
 I would futher grant that their sd front should extend downwards
 about one hundred perches lower taking in a bend of ye sd River cont.
 about 180 Acres & terminating ^{below} ~~at~~ a small rocky Run falling into ye sd
 River. These ye fore are to require thee to make Returns of the sd
 Tract according to their sd Request together wth the Islands opposite
 to ye sd front in ye River Skuykill lying on ye East side of ye Chan-
 nel for w^{ch} this shall be thy Authority. Given under my hand 14th
 8^{ber} 1701.
