

and require thee forthwith to Resurvey and layout ten Acres of
the best Improved and cleared Ground where the said Evan built
his house and planted an Orchard within the Liberties of the
City Philadelphia and make Returns into the Gen^t Surveyors
Office at Philad^{ia} by a Copy of this certified by the Secretary
Given under our hands and seal of the Province at Philad^{ia}
the 25th of ye 4th Moth 1705.</sup>
